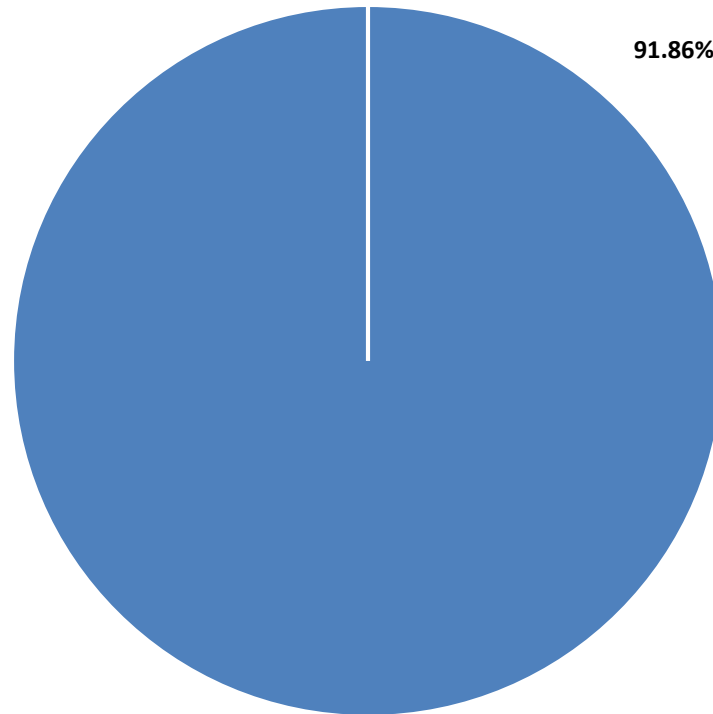

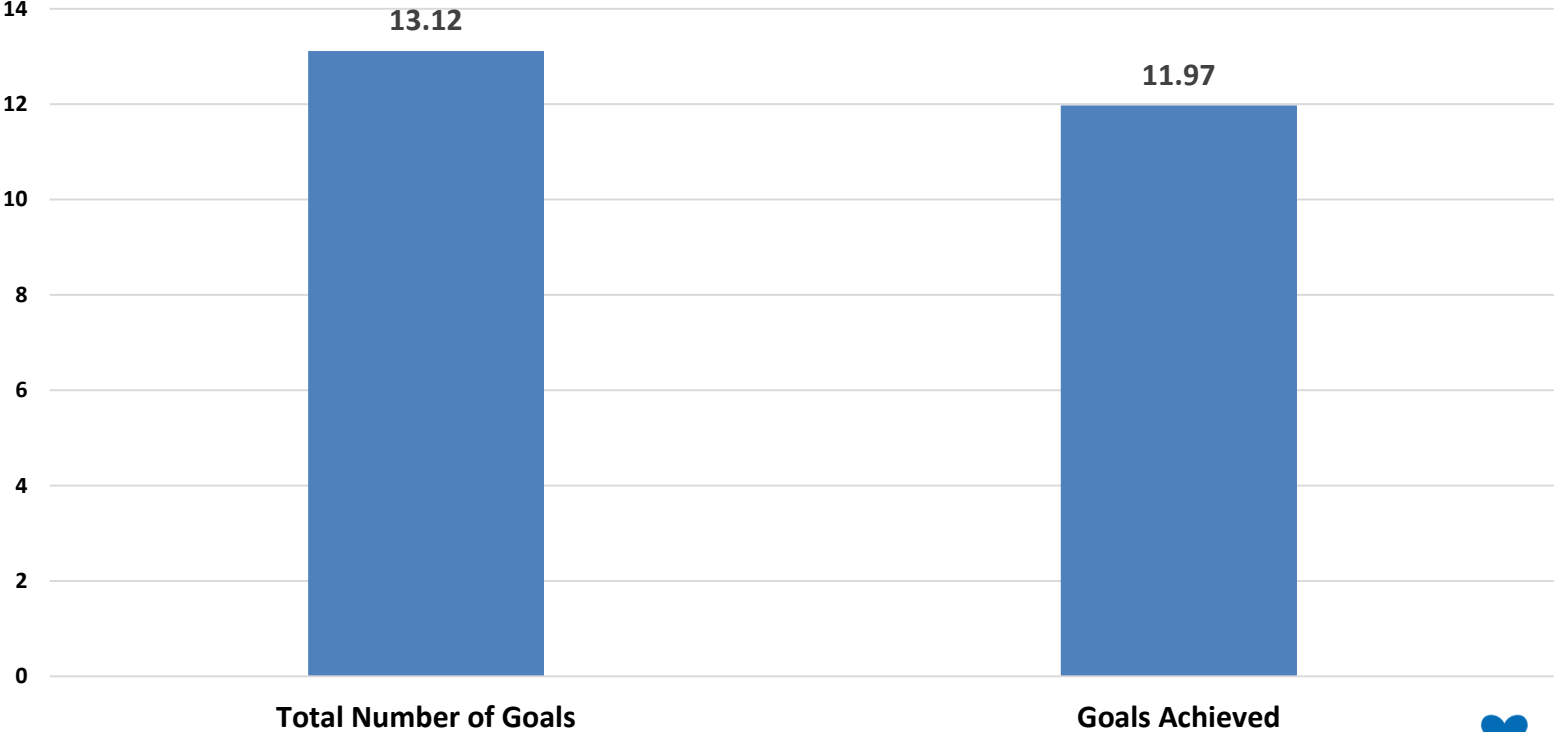
In 2023, the CPFID treated 78 patients who completed the intensive day patient program. The average admission was approximately 31 days. On average, our patients achieved 92% of their admissions goals

Our average patient had approximately 13 goals at admission.
58% of patients achieved 100% of their goals.

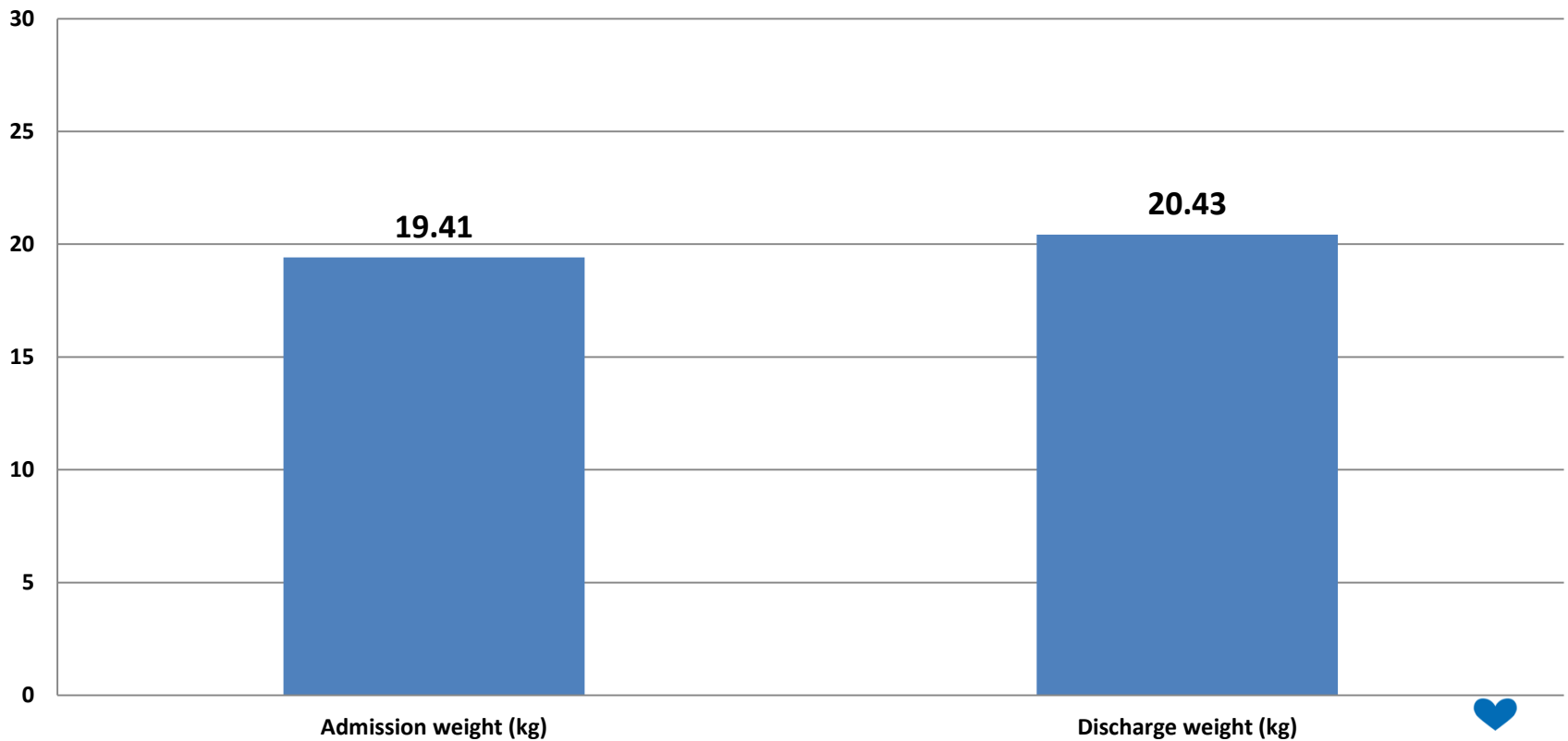
Average Feeding Goals and Goals Achieved, 2023 (n=79)

During a typically 6-8 week admission, the average gain in weight was 2.4 lbs. Note: for many patients weight maintenance, not gain, was a goal.

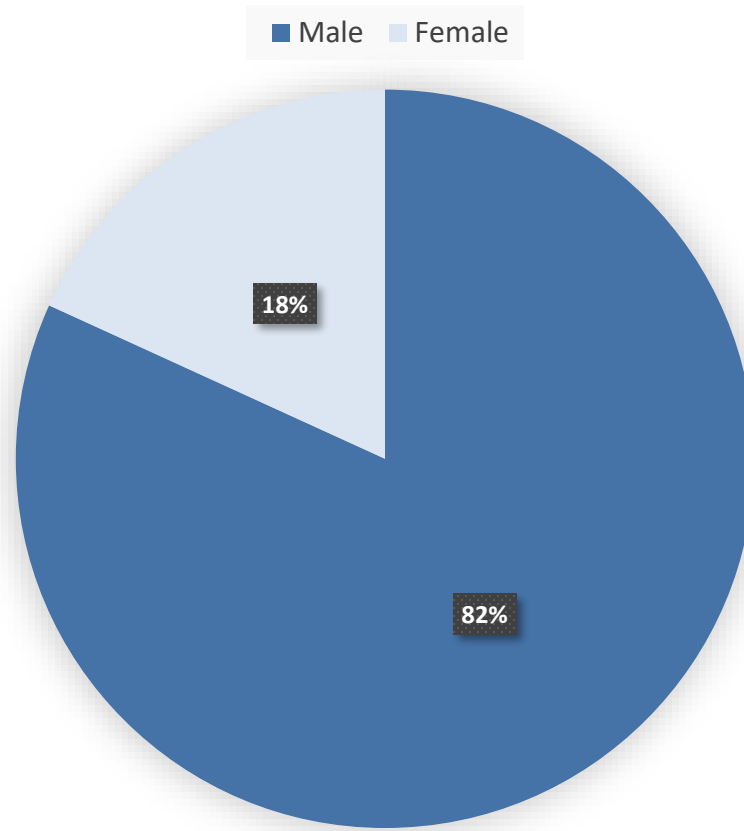
Average Weights, in kilograms, 2023 (n=79)

Average change in weight: 1 kg.



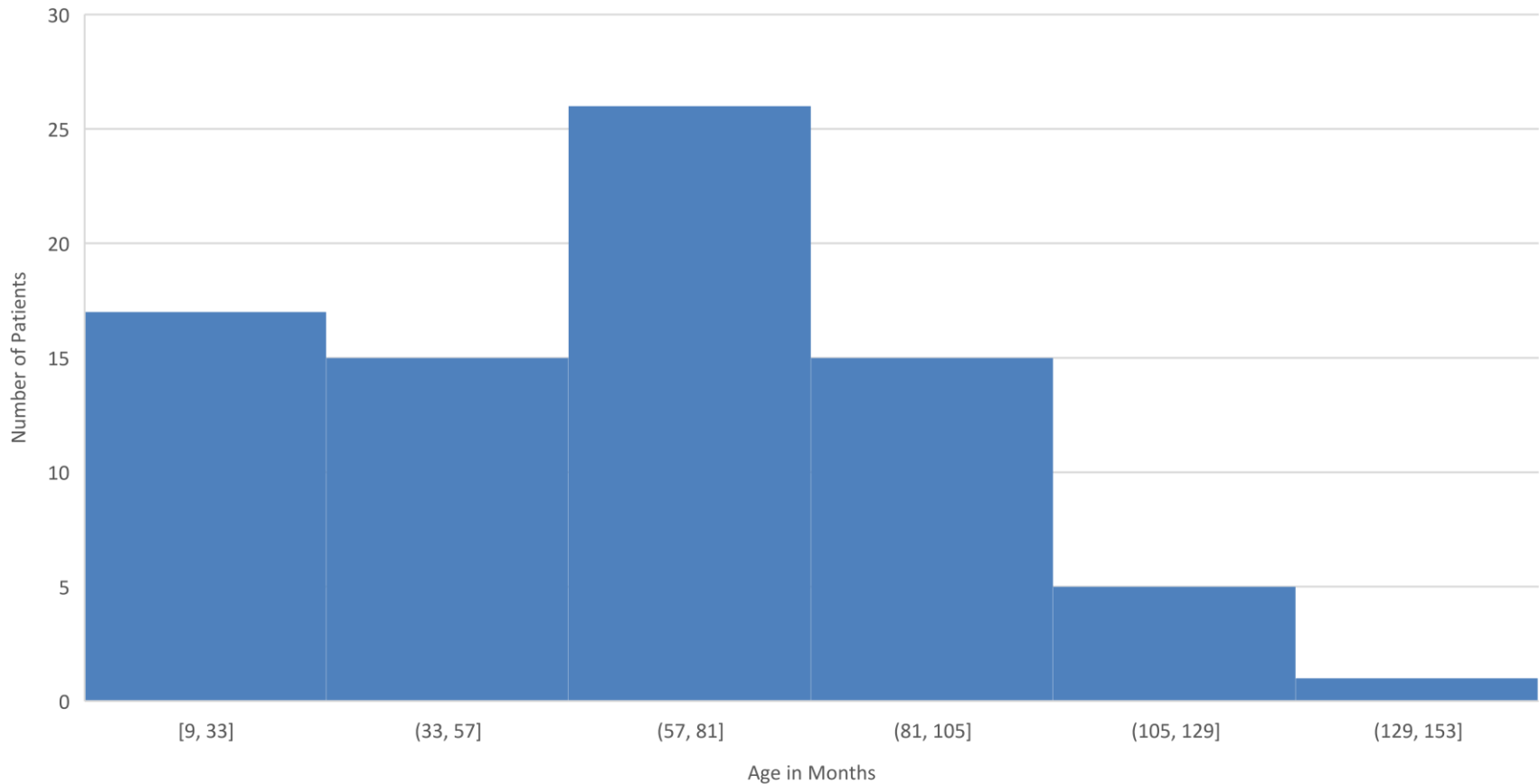
The majority of patients were male, which has been the prevailing pattern

Gender, 2023 (n=79)



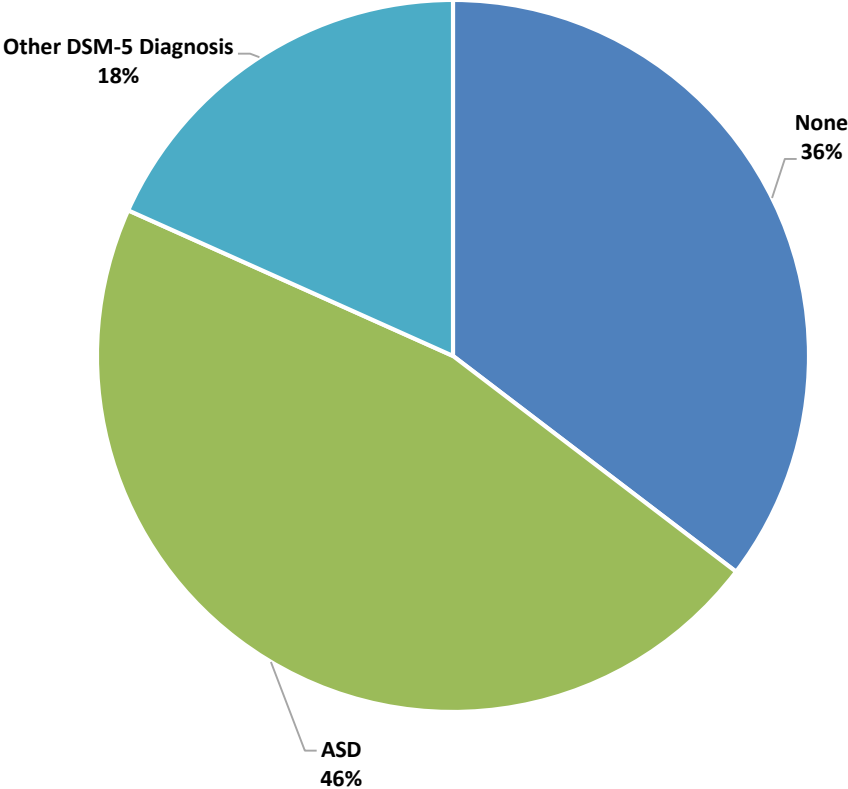
Average Age at Admission 62 months (5y, 2m). Range:

Age Distribution, 2023 (n=79)



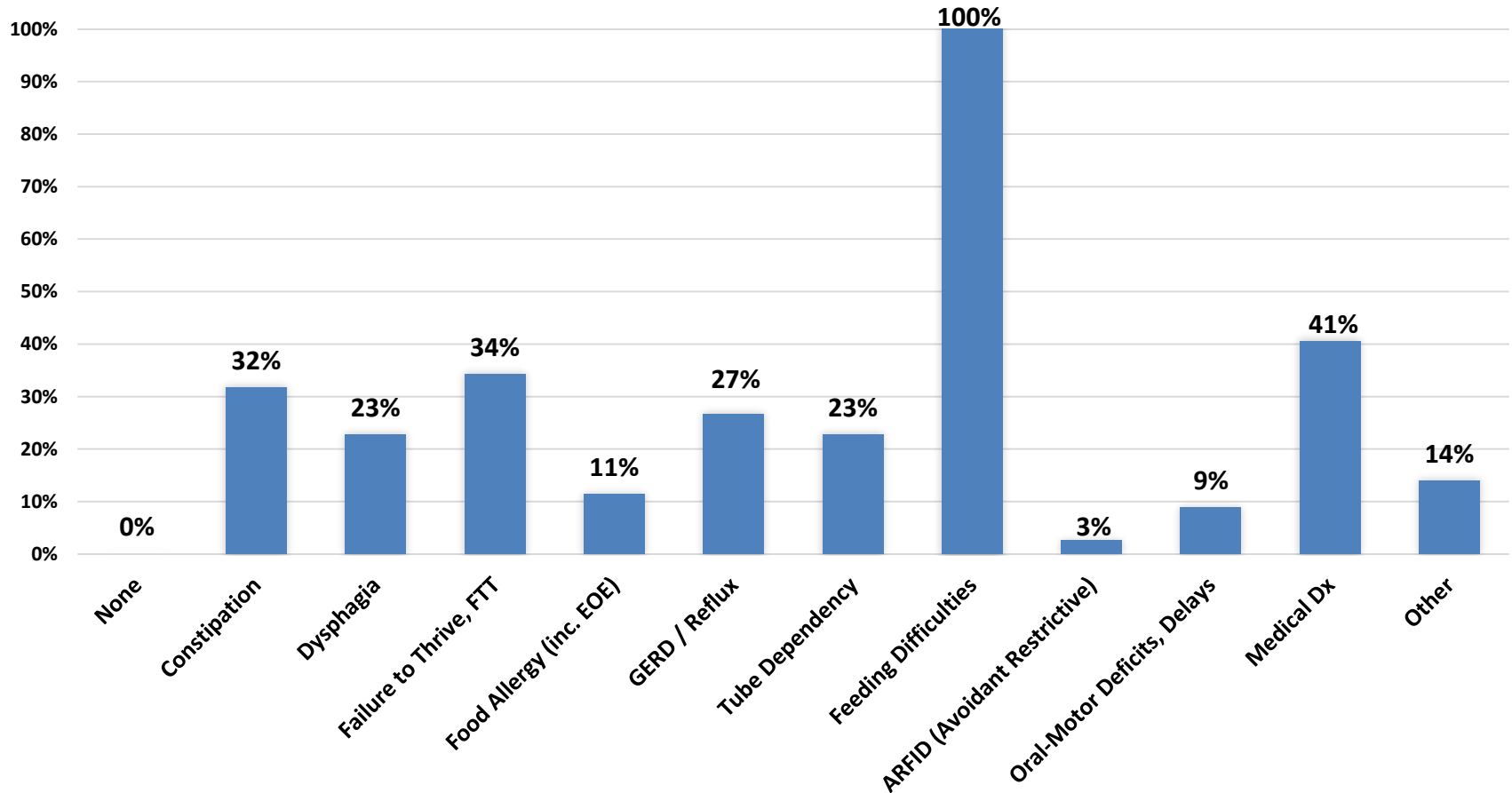

Diagnosis, Developmental and Psychiatric, 2023 (n=79)



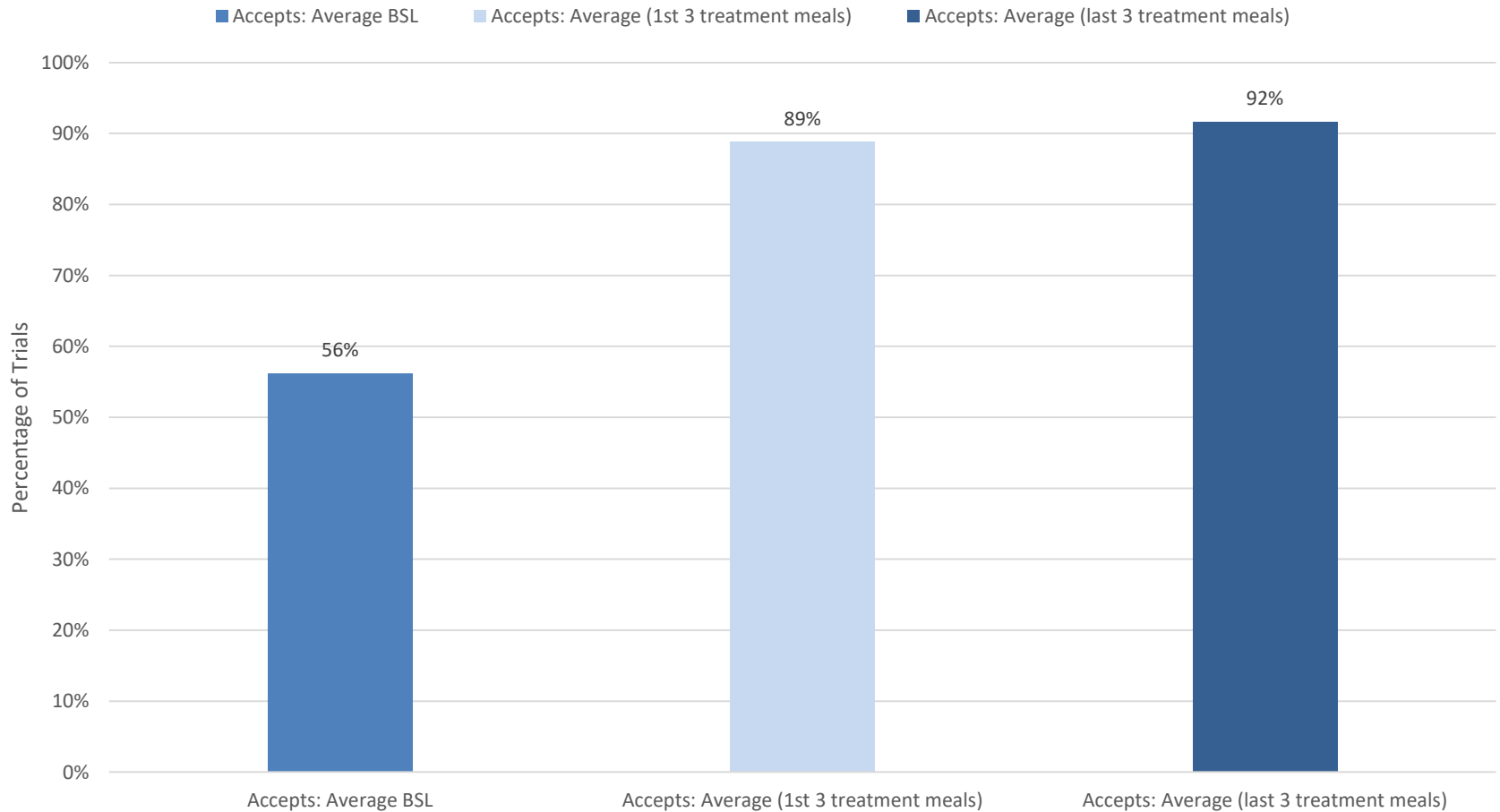
Prevalence of patients presenting with medical feeding-related diagnosis or conditions

Percentage of Patients with Gastric, Other Diagnoses/Conditions, 2023 (n=79)



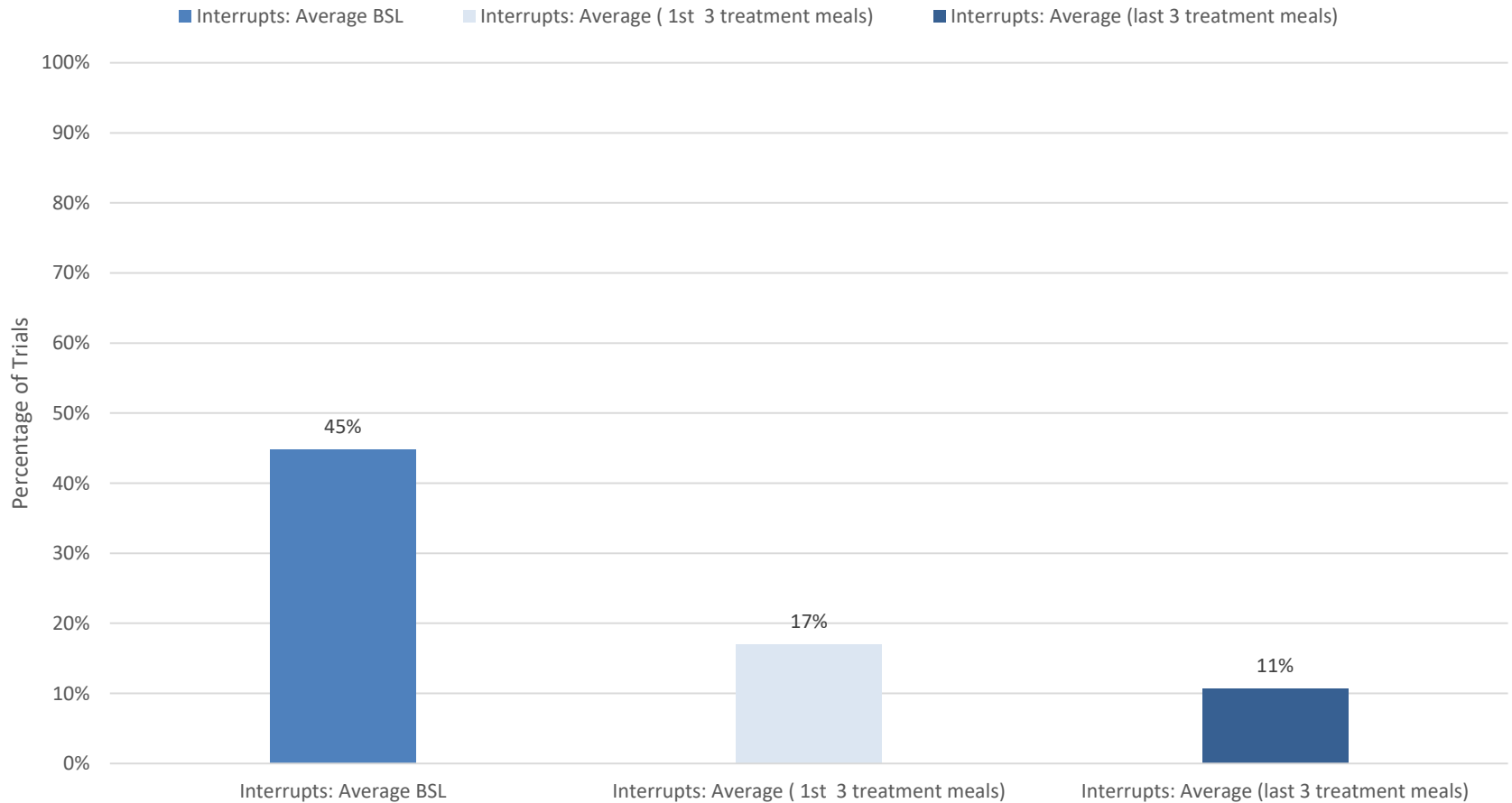
The average patient increased acceptance by 36%

Acceptance Behaviors, Percentage of Trials, 2023 (n=79)

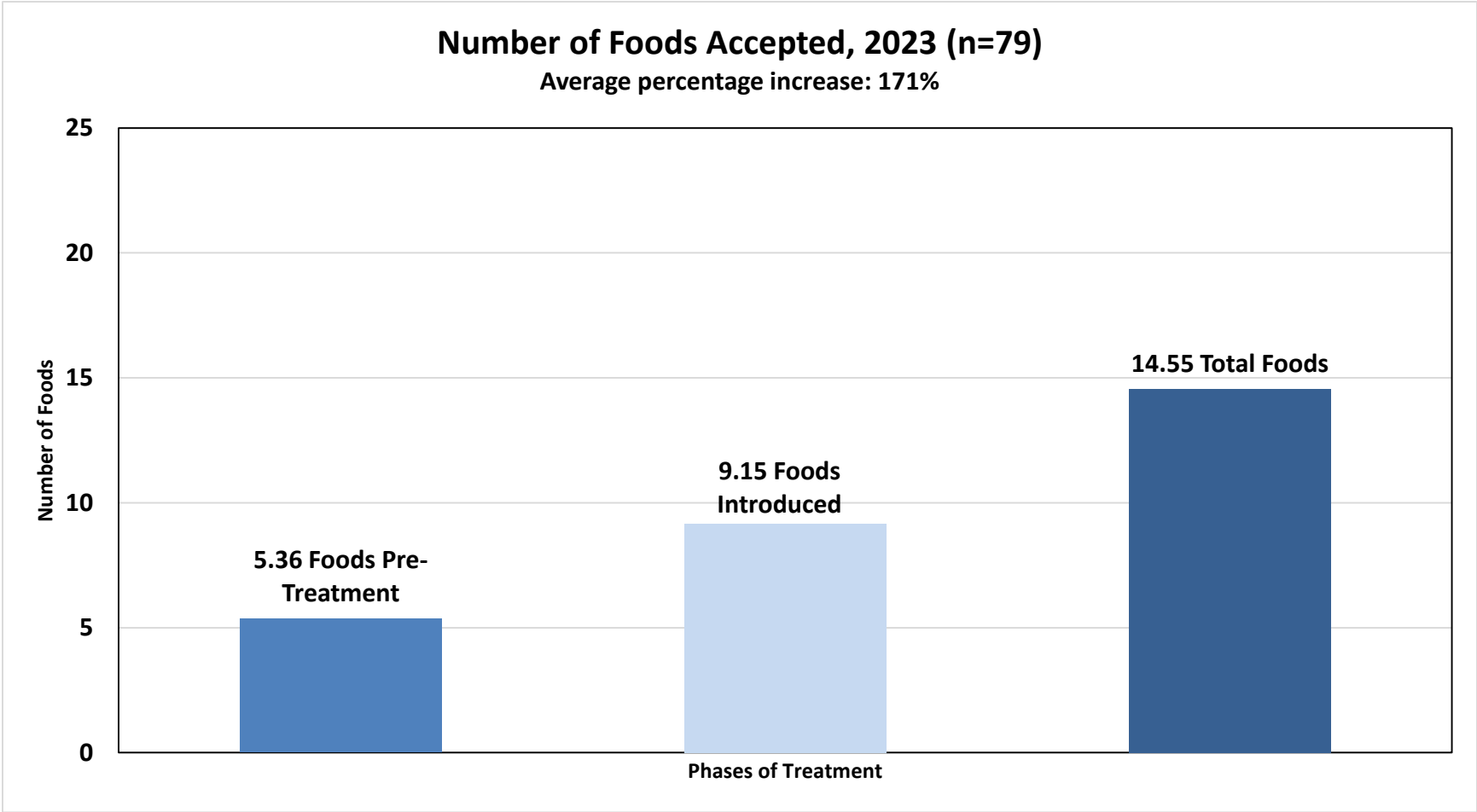


The average patient decreased interruption behaviors by 34%.

Interruption Behavior, Percentage of Trials, 2023 (n=79)



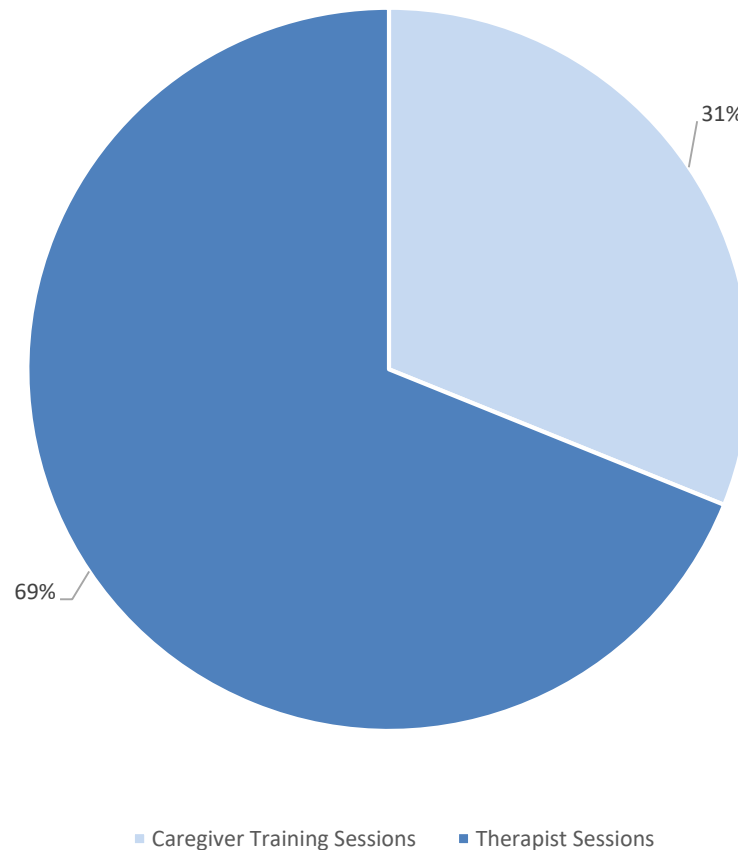
On average patients, added approximately 15 new foods, an increase of 171%, to their diets.

Note: Telehealth patients were excluded from this data as Caregiver Training accounted for 100% of those sessions

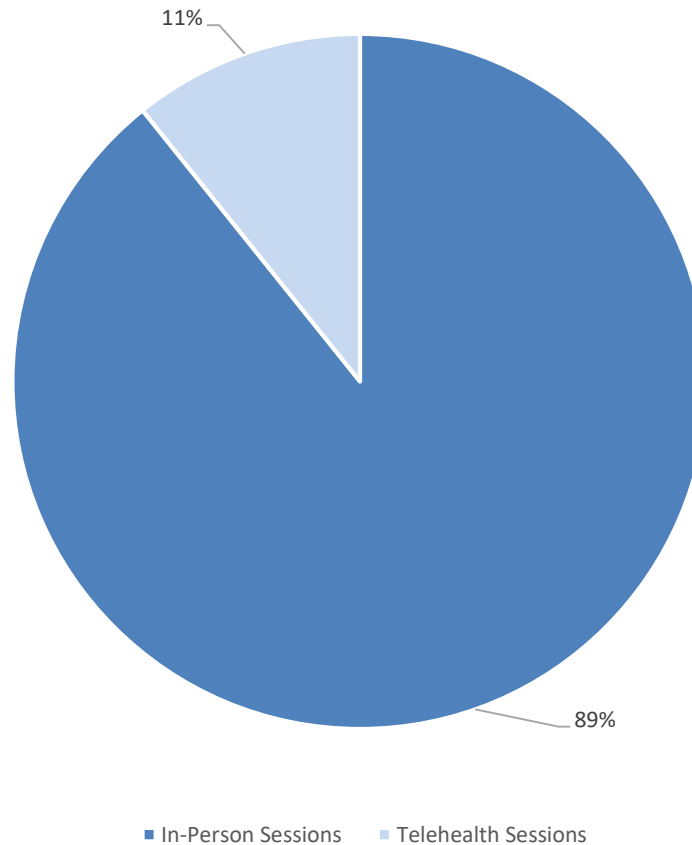
Breakdown of Therapist and Caregiver Training Meals, 2023 (n=64)

Note: Telehealth patients were excluded from this data as Telehealth accounted for 100% of those sessions

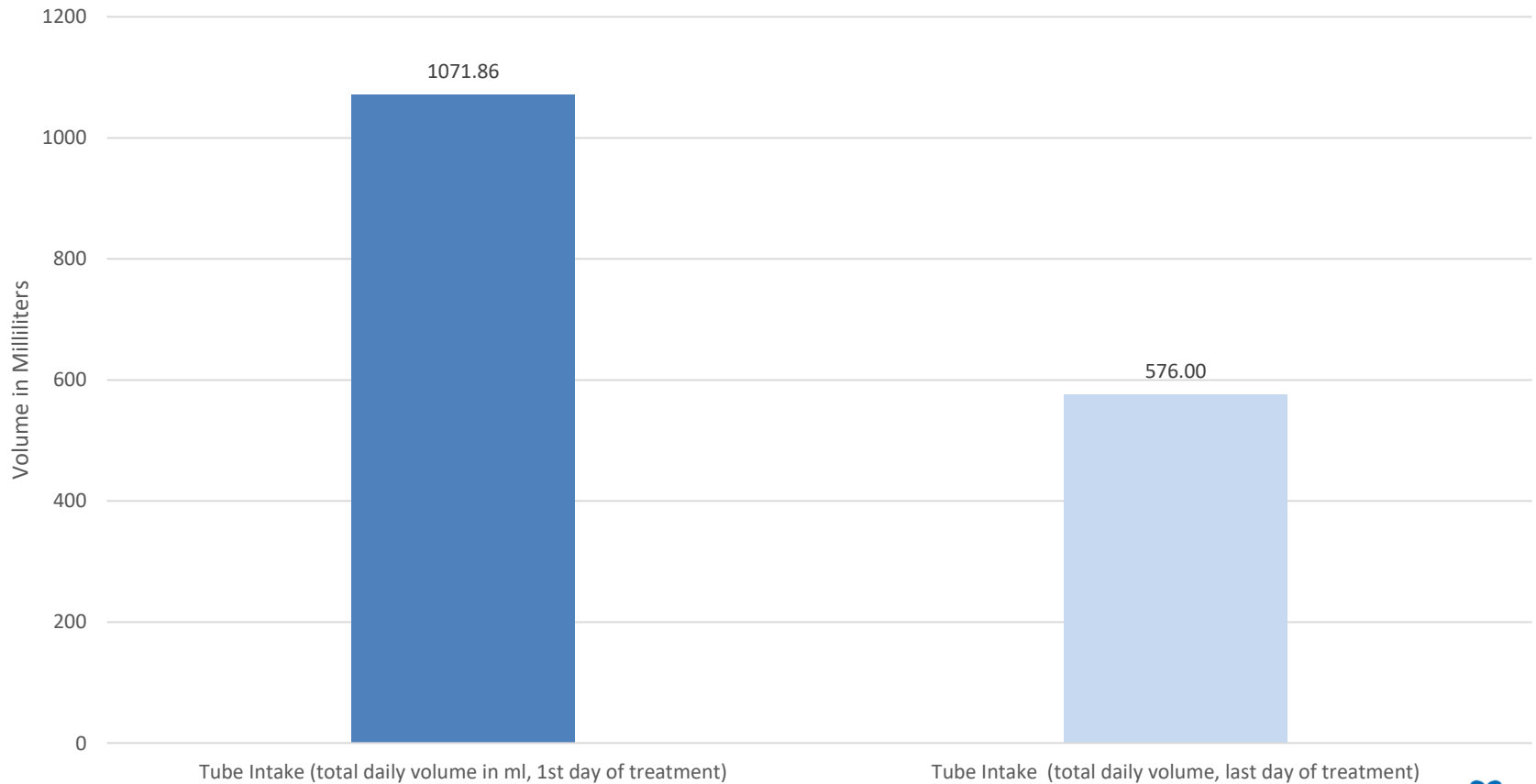
In-Person vs. Telehealth Sessions, 2023 (n=64)



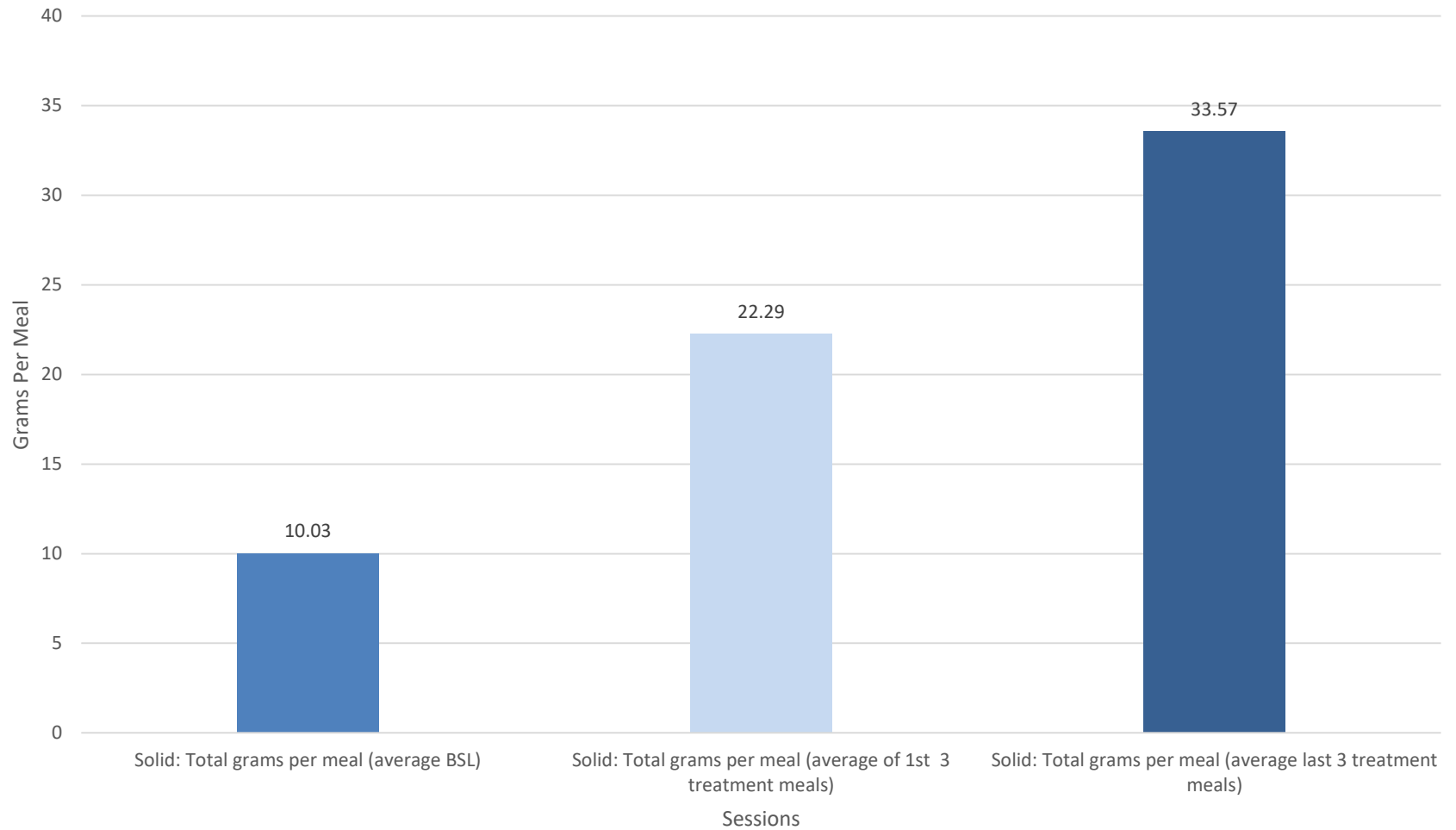
In 2023, 7 patients had a goal to decrease tube dependency.

Volume per Meal: Tube Intake, 2023 (n=7)

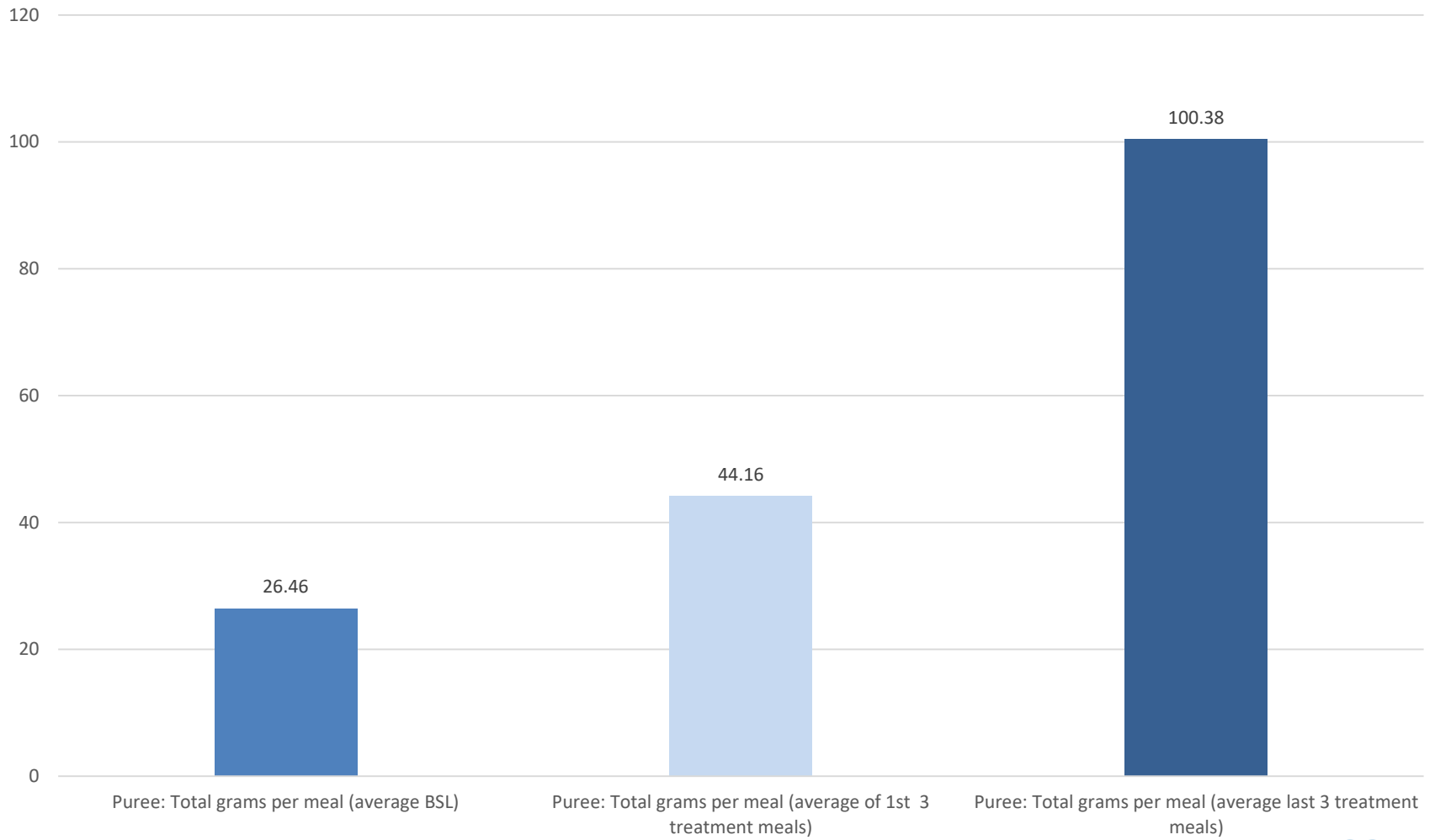
Note: 3 patients reduced tube by 100% during admission, and 2 others reduced by 100% shortly after discharge.



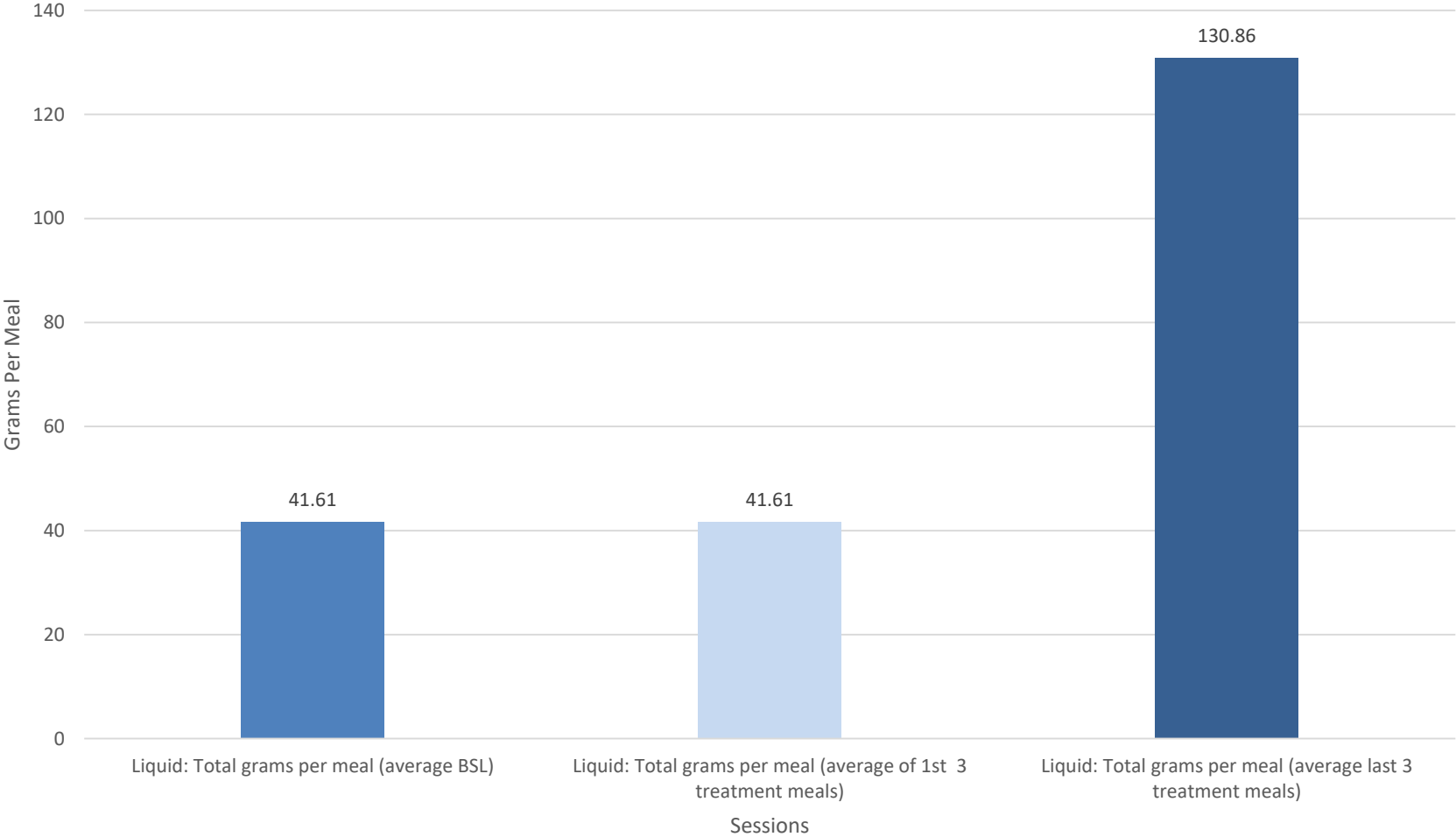
Grams Per Meal: Solids Only, 2023 (n=79)
