





Inventory & Labeling

As the seasons change, we request that parents take home excess (out of season or no longer fitting) clothing. When bringing in new clothes, please keep in mind

your child needs about 1 week worth of clothes (around 7 outfits). All new items must be brought directly to the nursing station and added to your child's Personal Belongings Inventory Sheet. Once they are inventoried, they will be sent to our Housekeeping Department for proper labeling. Please do not put items directly into your child's drawers without them being inventoried and labeled. This

process will prevent items from being misplaced or lost.

Family Hospitality

Dear Parents/Guardians,

during your child's admission our staff will make every effort to help you be as comfortable as possible. For your safety and your safety of all of the children, please partner with us on the following regulations:

- Food Storage __ No food storage is allowed in the resident rooms. Please store and eat your meals in the family room. A shared family refrigerator is available on each unit for your use. All food placed in the refrigerator must be labeled and dated.
- Washroom- By Dept. of Health regulation, only residents may use the bathroom facilities in the residents rooms. Family members may not use those facilities. Public Restrooms/washrooms are available on the unit hallway. The private shower room available for family use is located on the Ground floor in Building A.
